**PLACE OF SAFETY FOR ALL SCHOOL BUS RIDERS**

Policies for bus procedures are in place through both our Transportation Dept. and Ohio law. As stated in Ohio Revised Code 3801-83-13 (B)(6), all students who ride a bus to school are instructed to remain in their assigned place of safety when getting on or off the bus. Students are to be ready and waiting in their “safety zone” 10 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Students are NOT to wait at their house, vehicle, on their front porch, or in their garage. If the driver cannot see the student waiting, the driver will continue on to the next stop. Also, when students exit the bus at the end of the day, they are to go to their designated place of safety and REMAIN THERE until the bus departs to ensure drivers can visually account for all students to avoid any injury or accident.

Students who do NOT follow these policies and procedures are subject to disciplinary reports from the driver. Please keep in mind that several bus reports can result in the loss of bus privileges for an extended period of time.

Both parents and students should become familiar with what is expected for safe and orderly transportation to and from school. Please reinforce these policies with your child to promote the safety of all students being transported back and forth to school each day.
