Good Evening:

The safety and well-being of our students and staff is our number one priority. We are constantly monitoring information from a multitude of sources to inform our decisions.

This afternoon, Governor Mike Dewine held a press conference outlining the next steps in addressing the CoronaVirus. Based on his press conference and the guidance of the Ohio Department of Health, Brunswick City Schools will be implementing the following actions:

- **Based on the guidance to limit large gatherings, Effective Immediately, all School-Related Evening Concerts, Activities, Events & Community Use of School Facilities, Including the Middle School Musical are Postponed. BHS Athletic Practices Will Be Permitted to Continue for the Time Being.** New dates for these events/performances will be identified when we have a clear understanding of the situation.
- The **District Art Show** and **PRIDE Recognition Ceremony** scheduled during our board meeting on Monday, March 16th, will be postponed. The regularly scheduled board meeting will take place in the board office conference room.
- There will be **NO SCHOOL** for students on Tuesday, March 17th (Election Day), as voting is scheduled to occur in several buildings across our district. Buildings where voting takes place will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to students coming back the following day.
- During the school day, schools will limit access to parents and community members for non-essential visits.

Moving forward, the district will continue to provide parents and the community with regular updates on our emergency preparedness regarding this important public health issue. If we are informed that a staff or student has been in contact with someone or has contracted the coronavirus, we will work with the Medina County Health Department to determine the best options for district or building closure.

Thank you for your continued support of the Brunswick City School District as we continue to monitor this situation.
